Looking for Volunteers

The Big Sit is Sunday, October 13, 2024. I am looking for people to volunteer to fill a four hour shift between the hours 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM, the duration of the event. First shift will run 7 AM to 11 AM. Second shift is 11 AM to 3 PM. Third shift is 3 PM to 7 PM. We are looking for birders with fair knowledge of the birds in the area of Celery Fields, and with

comfort doing a checklist on the eBird App. I am moving the location to Raymond Boardwalk this year. This seems to be a better thoroughfare for all the bird species that frequent the Celery Fields.

Each shift will consist of 5 to 6 people. I would like to have a photographer for each shift to document the birds sighted and listed on eBird. Therefore, I need at least three photographers. I will be present on every shift to help, and I will

have my camera. If we don't have three photographers, I will certainly be there to photograph the birds listed, especially in the case of a rare species sighting.

Accuracy is everything. This means that an undercount is more desirable than an overcount. If it is an unfamiliar sighting, try to get a second opinion from a team member. You will be counting and identifying different species of birds that cross through or touch down in the Celery Fields

from the vantage of Raymond Boardwalk.
